To the City Council:

Gentlemen:

From recent newspaper publicity on Exposition programs and from the Administration headquarters directly, we regret to learn that there are to be concessions and exhibitions of nudism and other displays of unclothed or scantily clothed women. This is contrary to previous announcements.

We protest with the utmost vehemence against a repetition of these offences against decency, insults to men and women alike, which were so flagrant in the 1935 Exposition.

As citizens vitally interested in the moral standards and good name of our community, and conscientiously endeavoring to safeguard the morals of our young people and children, we therefore request that any and all contracts and permits for concessions or exhibitions of an indecent or immoral nature be cancelled and rescinded.

Finally, as taxpayers, we exercise our right to protest against the use of any portion of public lands for such purposes. May we hear from you as soon as possible as to your action on our request, so that our own plans concerning our participation and support of the
